Superintendent's Report – Randy Rockhold

Mr. Rockhold started with the Stronger Connection – in checking with the state the grant was granted in 23-24 school year. During the 23 – 24 school year no monies were spent. He received permission from the state to open up the back years and allow the auditor to move funds from the general fund to the Stronger Connection line allowing the school district to use more of the funds which runs out September of 2026. Documentation follows.

Next Mr. Rockhold discussed a budget he has put together that spans the next few years to bring the district back into the black. A copy of the documentation follows. Under New Business he is asking for the authority to move monies spent from the general fund to Contingency.

Discussion on the budget also included approval of freezes on wages, bonus checks for all employees, and temporary salary schedule for himself/

Principal's Report

Tracy Flanagan, principal has put a part time Science, full time science, and elementary position on the portal for hire. Thus far only one that has applied is from the US.

Tracy also reported discussions have started on schedule structuring and positions for the 25-26 year.

Courtney Reza moved to accept the transfers from the General fund as presented by Mr. Rockhold. Daniel Dunn seconded. Motion carried 6 – 0.

Courtney Reza moved to accept the proposal by Mr. Rockhold of Christmas Bonuses. Reyna Delgado seconded. Motion carried 6 – 0.

Mr. Rockhold asked permission to write a contract for himself to be presented at the December meeting. This was in agreement with the board.

Acquisition of Property**

Be it resolved the Board of Education of USD 217 Rolla District Schools has agreed to buy the following real estate property from Leland Lehnert for \$85,000.00.


401 Fifth Ave – A tract located in the Southeast Quarter (SE4) of Section Two (2), Township Thirty-four (34) South, Range Forty (40) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point eighty feet (80') South of the Southeast corner of Block Nine (9) in the Original Town of Rolla, Kansas, said point being the intersection of the South line of the Fifth Avenue and the West line of Adams Street; Thence South along the West line of Adams Street a distance of fifty-five (55') to a point; Thence West paralleling the South line of Fifth Avenue a distance of one hundred fifty feet (150') to a point; Thence North paralleling the West line of Adams Street a distance of fifty-five (55') to a point on the South line of Fifth Avenue; Thence East along the South line of Fifth Avenue a distance of one hundred fifty feet (150') to the point of beginning, Morton County, Kansas

Arrangements have been made through Frazee Abstract and Title, Inc., Syracuse, KS to finalize the sale. Mr. Randy Rockhold, Superintendent of Schools will be designated as the acquisitioner for the buy and Leland Lehnert as the seller.


